HOSPITALITY

Please provide 2 dressing rooms and 1 Production office.

These rooms must have a direct access to the stage, without crossing public area. Rooms must be lockable, ventilated, air-conditioned (min 21°C - max 25°C), well lit, with private toilets, shower and good wifi connection. Keys must be given to the tour manager upon his arrival.

Dressing rooms should welcome 5 people and will be distributed and equipped as follows :

1 x RAPHAEL GUALAZZI dressing room (1 person)

Equipment: a « lounge » corner with a sofa (rather big to lay down), a mirror, 1 fridge, two armchairs, two chairs, a big coffee table, a pleasant lighting, trash can, make-up corner, wardrobe with hanging facilities, coat hangers, paper tissues, soap and towels.

Please provide a digital 88 weighted keys stage piano with speakers. With ajustable piano bench

- 2 big white pre-washed towels

1 x BAND dressing room (2 people)

Equipment: a « lounge » corner with a sofa, mirror, 1 fridge, two armchairs, four chairs, a big coffee table, a pleasant lighting, trash can, make-up corner, wardrobe with hanging facilities, coat hangers, paper tissues, soap and towels.

- 10 small bottles of steel water (500ml)
- 2 big bottles of steel water (1L)
- 4 Coca-Cola cans
- 2 bottles of fresh juices
- Earl Grey, Herbal tea, Green tea and English breakfast tea with electric Kettle
- Fresh, hot coffee selection with sugar, milk, cups and spoon
- Bio Honey and lemon
- Knife, chopping board and bottle opener

TO BE GIVEN TO THE TOUR MANAGER UPON ARRIVAL (NOT IN THE DRESSING ROOMS)

- 2 bottles of good quality red wine with corkscrew
- 12 cold and good quality craft beers (<u>NO mainstream beers like</u> Heineken, Becks, Bud or similar)

1x PRODUCTION OFFICE (2 people)

Equiped with a phone line ready from the get in. High-speed internet access (Wifi or Ethernet – in case of Ethernet access, provide 2 cables). As well 2 clean office desks, chairs, coat hangers, printer, A4 paper sheets. Power plugs, adaptors and power sockets (220V AV/50HZ).

- 10 small bottles of steel water (500ml) for the stage
- 3 small **black pre-washed** towels for the stage and 1 big pre-washed towel
- Ironing board + iron

MEALS

The promoter will have to supply catering in the dressing rooms <u>ready for the load in time</u> and hot dinner for 4 people. Timing will be agreed during the advance of the show.

Catering:

- From our arrival, till the end of the show: cold meat (roasted veal and porc), bread, mixed cheese, mixed fresh vegetables, vegetarian basket with fresh fruits, home made pastries, cookies and candies. Any local or regional speciality foods are appreciated!!
- Fresh drinks near the stage (water, Coca-cola, sodas, etc).

Dinner:

Dinner should include first course, second course, side dish, salad and dessert with vegetarian options. Dinner shall be accompanied by appropriate beverages both alcoholic and not. <u>NO trash/fast food options</u>.

A copy of the Menu options must be left in production office.

Dinner should be usually served at least 2 hours BEFORE the performance. In case the artist will need to eat after the show the tour manager will advise in advance.

- 1 Jr. Suite / Superior king size bed room for Raphel Gualazzi
- 3 king size bed rooms
- Free in-room Internet Access
- Functioning air conditioning/heating

Please make sure there is NO construction, renovation, or any unusual activity.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Please provide a clean, non smoking and late model van that will carry minimum 6 passengers (not including driver) comfortably and 12 pieces of luggage.

Driver must be sober, fluently English speaking and with a functional cell phone.

ARTISTIC AND STAGE CONTROL

Artist has absolute artistic control as to the production and staging of the entire performance. Artist shall have first right of setup for all instruments and properties used in the production. Unless prior arrangements are made with ARTIST MANAGER, NONE OF THE ARTIST'S EQUIPMENT SHALL BE MOVED ONCE IT HAS BEEN SET UP.

REQUIRED LOCAL PERSONNEL

- 1 audio engineer who will run soundcheck and show
- 1 Monitor engineer who will run soundcheck and show
- 1 Stage manager
- 1 Backliner
- 1 Light designer who will run soundcheck and show

PLEASE be sure that the personnel listed above be qualified, sober and fluently in English.

PA SYSTEM

P.A must be of professional quality, minimum 3 ways active plus Subs such as: **Meyer Sound**, **D&B**, **L.A. acoustic**. We prefer flown / **Line Array systems** with bottom box at a minimum of 2 meters high from floor level. Stacked P.A will not be put on stage but on sound wings 50cm to 1m away from the stage.

For the sub system, arc sub and cardio if possible.

P.A MUST be able to provide 105 dBA of clear and undistorted sound throughout the whole venue or festival location. If necessary, provide « front-fills » for the firsts seats, and delayed speakers for the distant seats or out of field.

FOH

The FOH will be located in the middle of the audience, on the floor (avoid risers except for festival configurations), please choose the best listening position (try not to put it near a wall, under or on a balcony).

MONITOR SYSTEM

LIGHTING



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MEDIA POLICY

Any kind of interview, radio appearance, television or any other promotional form, must be previously agreed with the artist.

To minimize interruptions and disruption to the performance, professional photographers can shoot only during the first three songs, from precise sites in the hall that will be communicated by the artist's tour manger before the beginning of the concert. NO flash allowed.

Accredited photographers will be notified in advance to the artist's tour manager, who reserves the right to approve their presence and will instruct about how to operate.

No photo sessions can be arranged, except upon specific request that must be sent at least one week before the day of the show for approval to <u>lorenzo.pioppi@internationalmusic.it</u>.

Accredited Television filming during the performance can be made from specific sites that do not interfere with the audience view. Shooting are limited to the first two songs performed. For other filming needs specific contracts have to be signed contacting <u>lorenzo.pioppi@internationalmusic.it</u>. Video crews can be connected to audio mixer only after a briefing with the tour manager and the FOH engineer who will inform about the procedure case by case.

All photographers and video crews must be in possession of press accreditation and/or specific pass. A list of these people must be at the band's tour manager disposal.

No audio recording of the concert is allowed except the 3 minutes for the TV rights. All other recordings must be regulated by a separate contract in advance with lorenzo.pioppi@internationalmusic.it.

INTERVIEWS

No interviews can be arranged with the artists on the performance's day. However, if there are important requests from newspapers/radio/TV News you should submit them to lorenzo.pioppi@internationalmusic.it with reasonable advance for approval.

USE OF THE NAME OF THE ARTIST

The Promoter will have the right to exploit the name of the Company solely for the exploitation of the performance hereunder. The performance hereunder will not be sponsored by or tied in with any commercial product or company, unless approved by the Producer in writing, in advance. There will be no signs, advertising materials, etc. on or near the stage at any time during the Company's performance.
